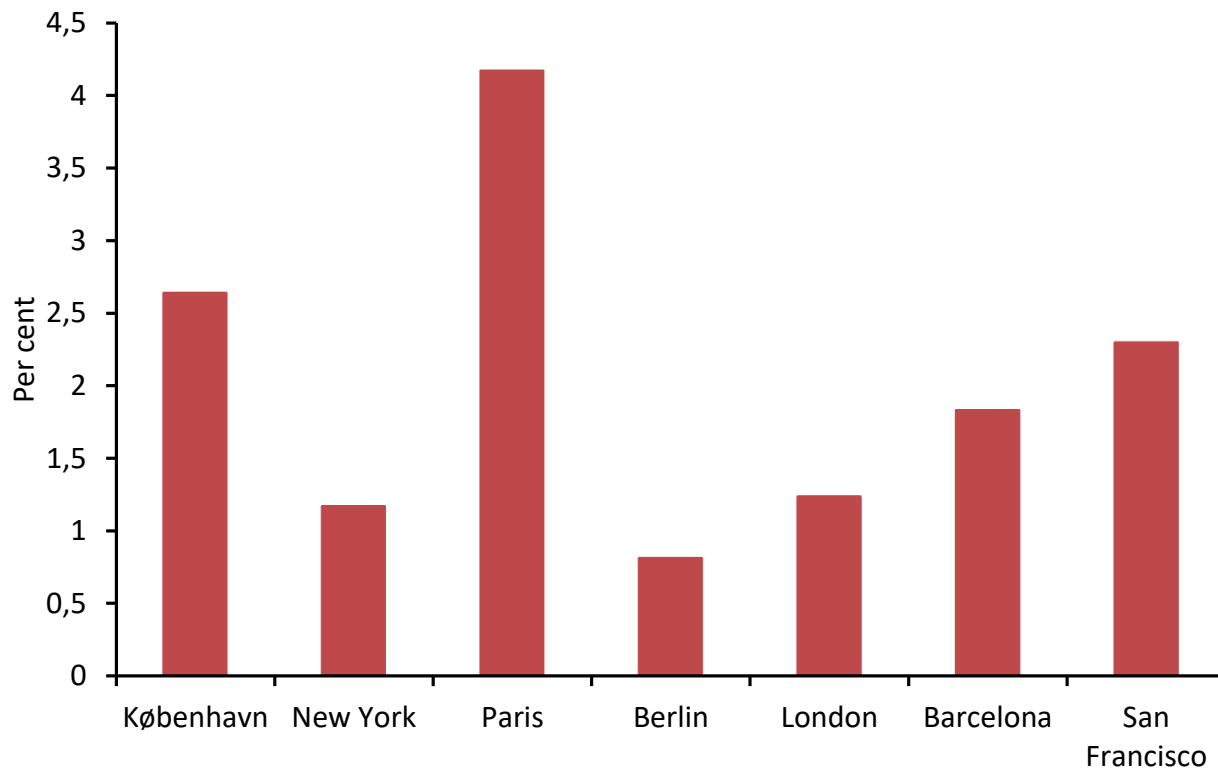

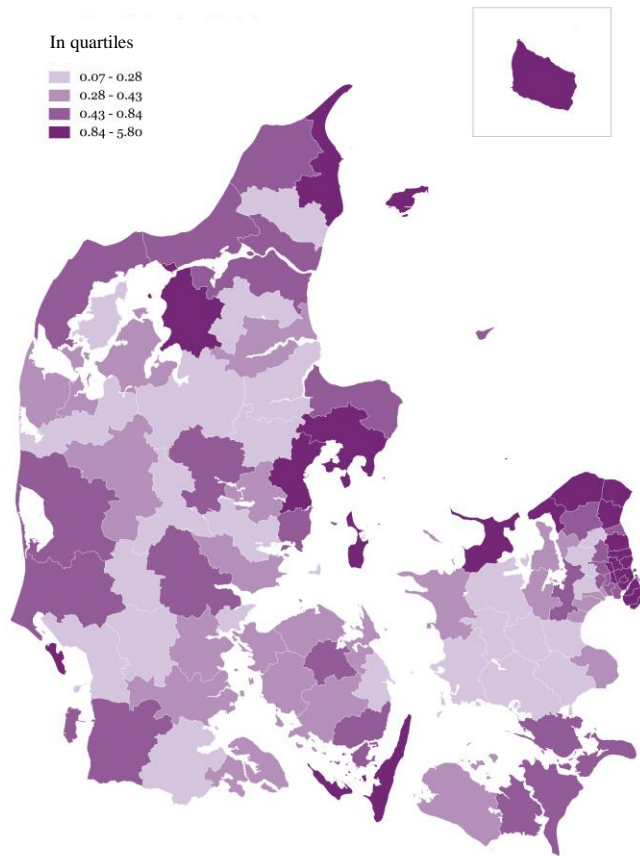

# Share of homes on Airbnb in Denmark 2017

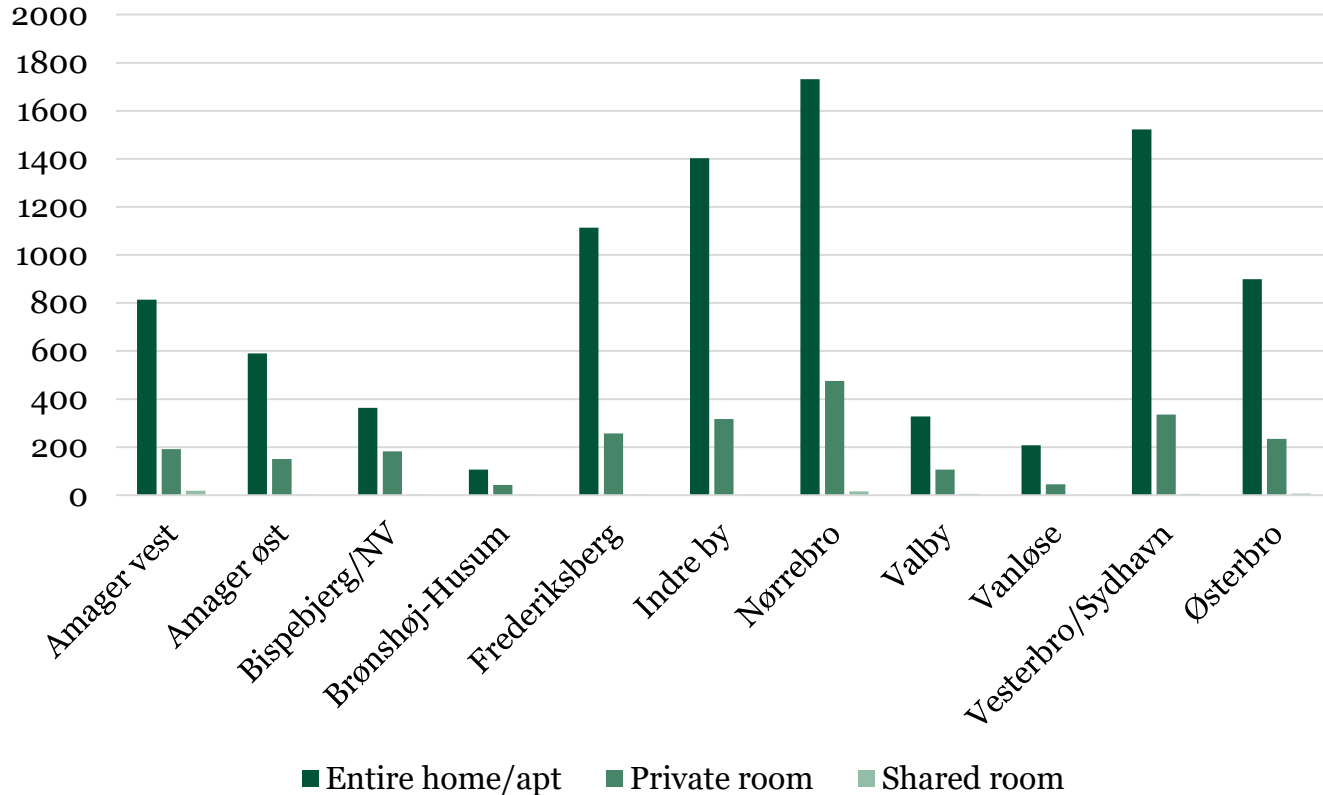

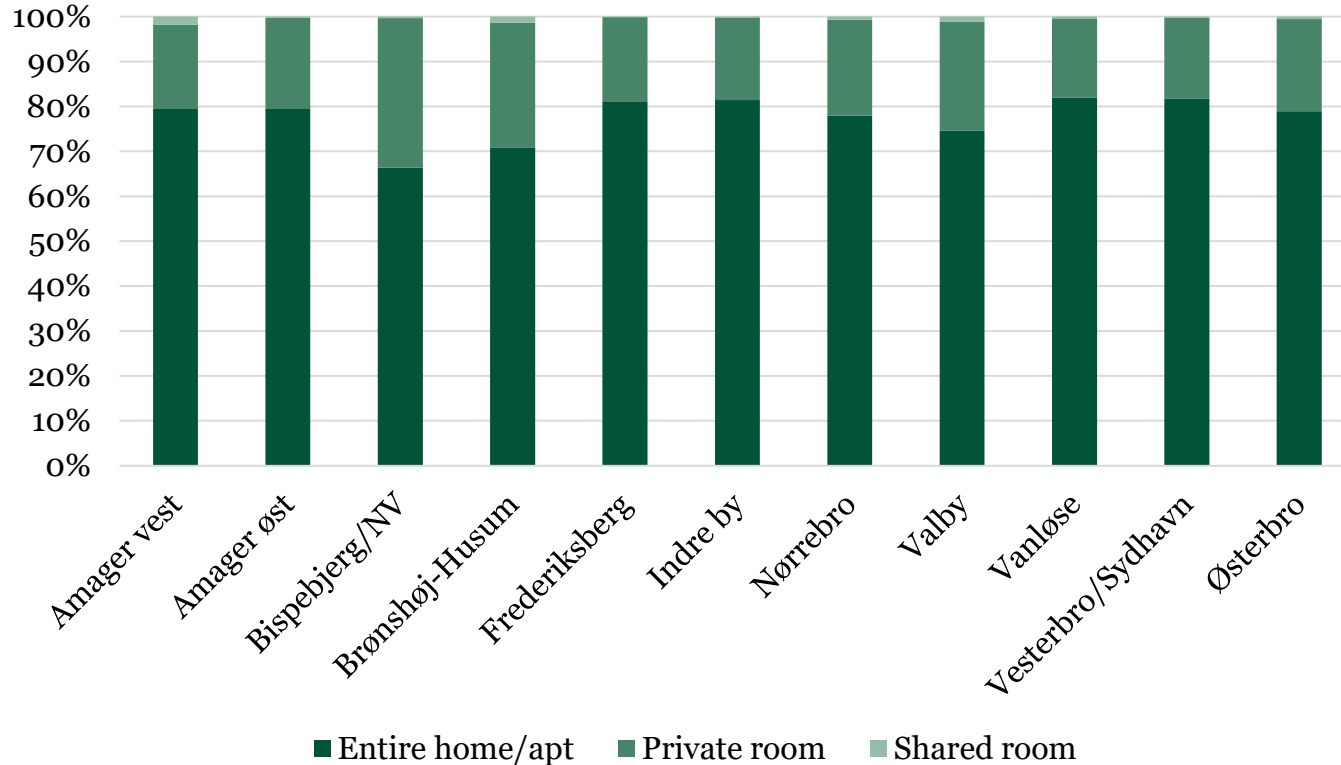

# The distribution of listings in Copenhagen

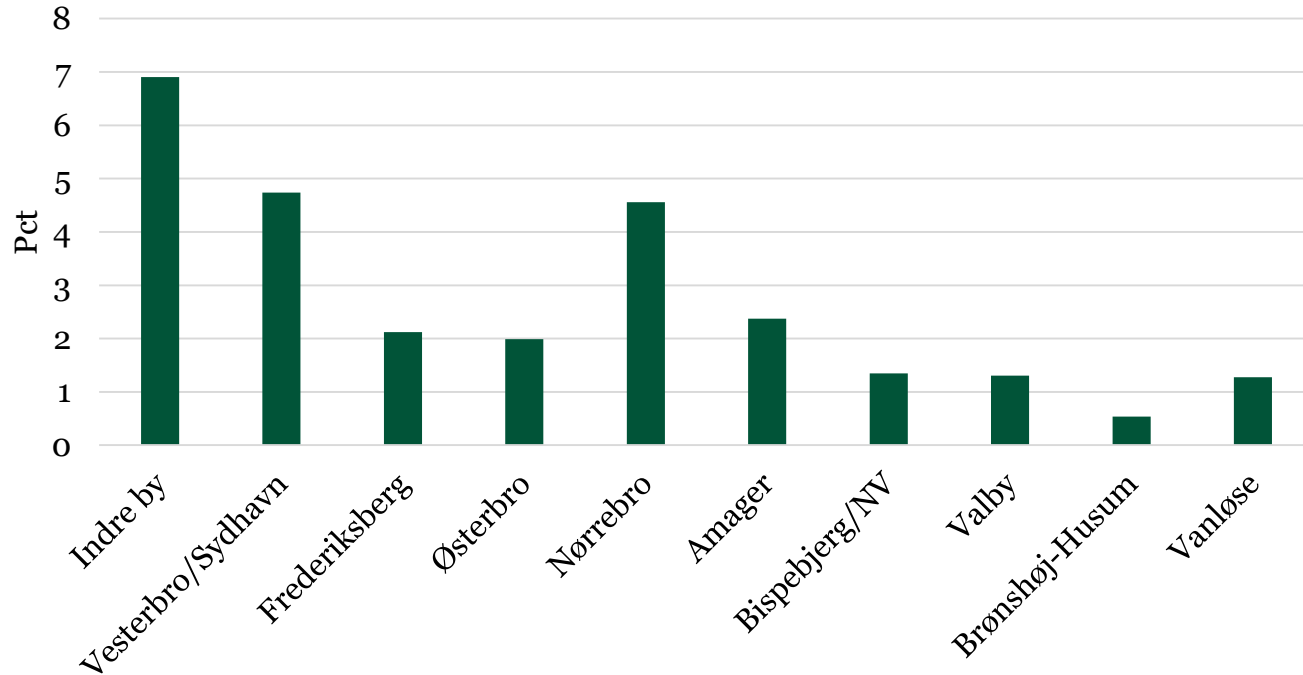

# Share of housing rented out

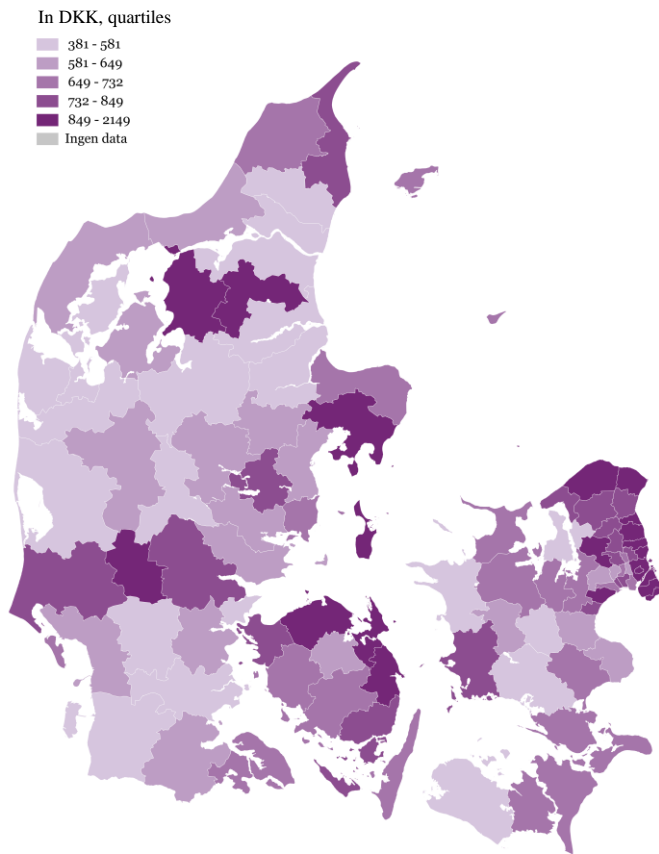

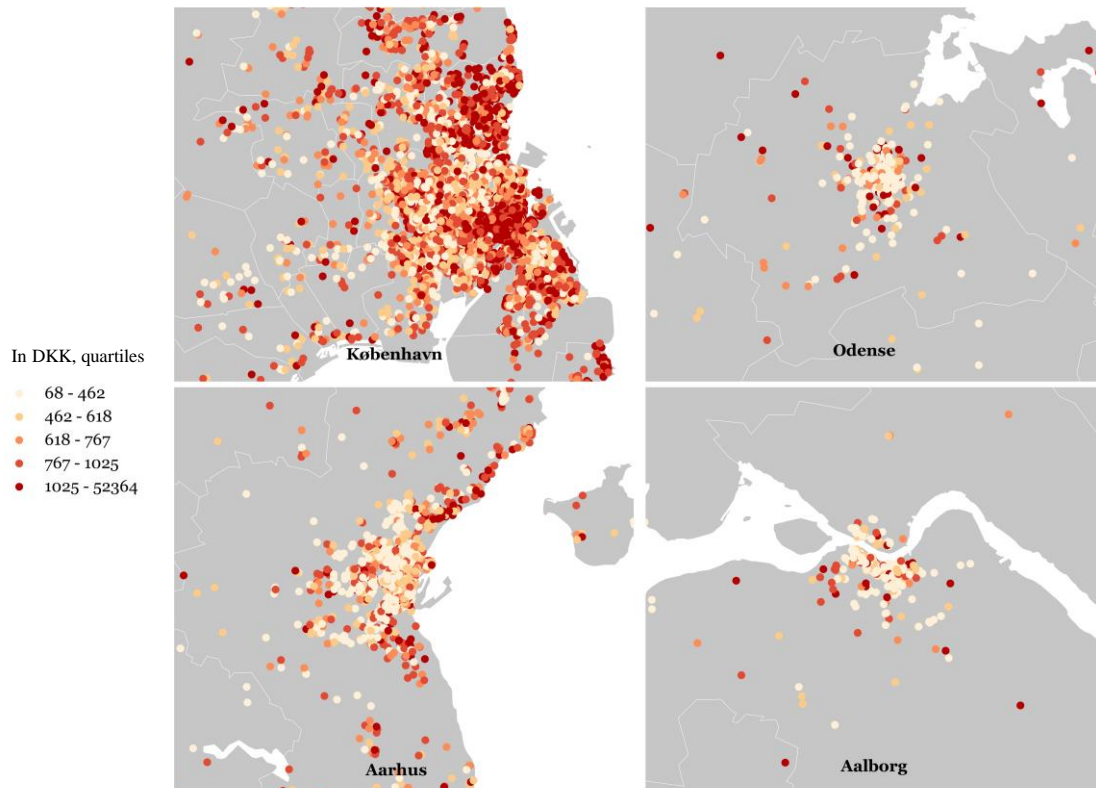
# Prices per night, entire homes, 2017
